SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE AND OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES IN THE TOWN OF SILVER CLIPPD FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCESS TO SNOWMOBILE TRAILS IN AND OUT OF SAID TOWN.

The Town Board of Silver Cliff Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

SECTION I. The state snowmobile laws are adopted. Except as otherwise provided in this ordinance, the statutory provisions and defining regulation with respect to snowmobiles in the Wisconsin Statutes are hereby adopted and made part of this

ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Acts required to be performed or prohibited by such statutes are required by this ordinance. SECTION II. Snowmobile routes are to be so designated. following roads in the Town of Silver Cliff Marinette, County, Wisconsin are hereby described as snowmobile routes: All Unplowed Roads D. H. Hwy. "C" (Back page E. B. I. Hwy. "C" (Back page)F. SECTION III. All other action heretofore enacted by the Board of Silver Cliff which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. SECTION IV. Limitations. Operation of snowmobiles on the foregoing designated routes shall be subject to the following limitations. Snowmobiles shall be operated on the extreme right side of the roadway. Left turns shall be made as safely as possible from any position depending on snow cover and other prevailing conditions. Snowmobiles shall make a complete stop before C. crossing unplowed roads. Snowmobile operators shall yield the right-of-way D. to other vehicular traffic. SECTION V. This ordinance in effect per unanimous vote of the Town Board of Silver Cliffon March 7, 1905 . Rights granted herein to be in effect indefinitely unless notice of intention to rescind given to concerned parties thirty (30) days prior to doing so.
