American Legion State Delegation. Ann and Barb are Associate Deputies at the Iron Mountain Veterans Facility.



Silver Cliff Rescue had an extremely busy year and responded to 144 calls which set a record for the number of responses crews have made. This year, 85 calls were in Silver Cliff, 57 were in Athelstane and 2 were in Twin Bridge. The breakdown includes: Altered Level of consciousness 10, ill 21, stroke 5, lift assist/fall 25, OD 1, medical alert 2, motor vehicle accident 8, pain 10, cardiac 5, anxiety 1, head injury 4, seizure 3, difficulty breathing 9, ATV/UTV accident 2, standby for fire department 3, accident 2, bicycle/dirt bike 3, altercation 1, fracture/dislocation 5, bleed 6, allergic reaction 3, burns 2, diabetic 2, chemical imbalance 3, dehydration 2, poisoning 1, high blood pressure 3, standby for

law enforcement 1, and deaths 5. A few were in more than 1 category.

Squad Billing would like to remind everyone that if the squad is called for you, you will receive a bill. Most insurance will not pay that bill if you are not transported to a medical facility, so unfortunately, you will be responsible for the bill.

EMTS would like to remind everyone to drink at least 2 to 4 glasses of water a day. For every caffeinated beverage, you should drink twice that amount in no-caffeine or decaffeinated beverages. As people age, they tend to drink less water. Not drinking enough water can lead to urinary tract infections, dehydration, and a host of other increasingly serious issues. The dry air during winter compounds the problem. Many of our illness calls were attributed to this issue.

SCRS thanks to our local business who have a HELP container on the counter. We appreciate you for allowing us a little space and encouraging your patrons to donate a little here and there. It really adds up and we're grateful.
